



Galatians Chapter 6

As we move through the 6th chapter of the book of Galatians here this morning I want us to know and understand that when we are finished here today.. we will have completed our study on the book of Galatians.

The 6th chapter of the book of Galatians being one of the smallest chapters but none the less just as important as all of the other chapters in the book of Galatians. So before we read this last chapter and end our study on this particular book... this letter from the Apostle Paul to the church at Galatia.. I want us to think about what we've already learned in this particular letter from the Apostle Paul.

We know from the beginning that the church of Galatia was under attack from what was known as the “circumcision group” that was following Paul around and trying to confuse the new believers by claiming that “circumcision” is what saved them.

They were trying to teach and preach against the Gospel message that Paul had already taught and preached to them. We know that circumcision does not save anyone anymore than baptism saves anyone. These are both acts of faith, not acts of works at least as far as the true Christian is concerned.

Thinking that circumcision or baptism saves a person is returning to pursuing the law as though it were based on works. Because you think that by doing something with your own hands.. that you can earn your way into Heaven. And this is wrong.

And once again as we've already seen in this study, it's important to understand that this is exactly why Israel could not attain the law that would have lead to righteousness in the first place. If they would have kept the law by faith according to the Apostle Paul.. they would have attained righteousness through the grace of God by keeping his law in the first place.

Once again lets read what Paul has already made very clear:

Rom 9:30 What shall we say, then? That Gentiles who did not pursue righteousness have attained it, that is, a righteousness that is by faith;

Rom 9:31 but that Israel who pursued a law that would lead to righteousness did not succeed in reaching that law.

*Rom 9:32 Why? **Because they did not pursue it by faith**, but as if it were based on works. They have stumbled over the stumbling stone,*

Once again my friends the Israelite's could have attained righteousness through the grace of god by keeping the law if they would have kept it by faith, but they did not. You see instead of keeping the law because they loved God.. they kept the law because they thought that it was what saved them. They confused the “Law” of God with the “Grace” of God.

They thought that by keeping the law they were earning their way into Heaven by their own hands. So they believed that Gods grace really had nothing to do with it. All they had to do was to keep the law and they could earn their way in. This was wrong and not what God had ever said or taught them.

They (the Israelite's) were already saved by the “grace” of God. He had already chosen them as his people because Abraham truly loved God and knew how to pursue the laws of God by faith correctly:

Gen 26:4 I will multiply your offspring as the stars of heaven and will give to your offspring all these lands. And in your offspring all the nations of the earth shall be blessed,

Gen 26:5 because Abraham obeyed my voice and kept my charge, my commandments, my statutes, and my laws."

You see Abraham did not keep Gods commandments because he was earning his way into the kingdom of Heaven by his own works in keeping the law. Abraham kept the commandments of God and his statutes, and his laws because he loved God there is a difference in how Abraham pursued the laws of God.

Abraham did not stumble over the stumbling stone like the Israelite's did. To them the law of God was a burden. But to those of us who love God.. his laws, commandments, precepts, and appointments are not burdensome:

1Jn 5:2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey his commandments.

1Jn 5:3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome.

Lets go ahead and read through the last chapter of the book of Galatians but let me warn those of you who may be joining us for the first time.. if you have not been with us from the beginning of this study, and you belong to one man made, man created, man fabricated denominational charter or another you will not understand what we're teaching here unless you have been with us from the beginning of this study.

We at HolyImpactMinistries.com do not hold to any man made, man created, man fabricated Christian denominational doctrines or theologies nor do we hold fast to any papal bull. We teach from scripture and scripture alone, and we are void of any denominational dogma, or doctrine. We have washed our hands of those man made, man created, man fabricated things and have left those things in the dust behind us.

If it's not found in the scripture we don't do it, and if it is found in the scripture, then we do do it. It's just that simple for us, and we don't need any man made, man created, man fabricated doctrine, religious system, or theology mixed in with Gods Word in order to understand Gods Word.

So once again.. if you're holding fast to your man made, man created, man fabricated denominational doctrine.. and your man made, man created, man fabricated religious system, and your holding fast to your man made, man created, man fabricated papal bull...you will not be able to understand what we're teaching here. Because what we teach comes from scripture and scripture alone.

2Ti 3:16 All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,

2Ti 3:17 that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

Notice... it says ALL SCRIPTURE not ALL DENOMINATIONAL DOCTRINES OF MEN!

Just a warning for those of you who are still chained and bound by the bondage of today's over 5000 different denominational charters of men and their lawless and twisted teachings. And if you are still bound by one of these man made, man created, man fabricated doctrine of demons we urge you to take heed to the warning of the Apostle Peter in 2nd Peter 3:16:

2Pe 3:15 And count the patience of our Lord as salvation, just as our beloved brother Paul also wrote to you according to the wisdom given him,

2Pe 3:16 as he does in all his letters when he speaks in them of these matters. There are some things in them that are hard to understand, which the ignorant and unstable twist to their own destruction, as they do the other Scriptures.

2Pe 3:17 You therefore, beloved, knowing this beforehand, take care that you are not carried away with the error of lawless people and lose your own stability.

And so with that being said... I always like to let the new viewers be warned, not to belittle anyone but to let them know the truth of Gods Word... we don't care about what your denominational doctrine says or teaches.. we only care about the truth found in scripture because anything more or less than what is found in scripture is simply a waste of time and effort.

So with that being said lets read the 6th chapter of the book of Galatians:

Gal 6:1 Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted.

Gal 6:2 Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

Gal 6:3 For if anyone thinks he is something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself.

Gal 6:4 But let each one test his own work, and then his reason to boast will be in himself alone and not in his neighbor.

Gal 6:5 For each will have to bear his own load.

Gal 6:6 Let the one who is taught the word share all good things with the one who teaches.

Gal 6:7 Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap.

Gal 6:8 For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.

Gal 6:9 And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up.

Gal 6:10 So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith.

Gal 6:11 See with what large letters I am writing to you with my own hand.

Gal 6:12 It is those who want to make a good showing in the flesh who would force you to be circumcised, and only in order that they may not be persecuted for the cross of Christ.

Gal 6:13 For even those who are circumcised do not themselves keep the law, but they desire to have you circumcised that they may boast in your flesh.

Gal 6:14 But far be it from me to boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.

Gal 6:15 For neither circumcision counts for anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation.

Gal 6:16 And as for all who walk by this rule, peace and mercy be upon them, and upon the Israel of God.

Gal 6:17 From now on let no one cause me trouble, for I bear on my body the marks of Jesus.

Gal 6:18 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit, brothers. Amen.

So what is this “Law of Messiah” or “Law of Christ” that we see in Galatians 6 verse 1? The law of “Messiah” or “Christ” is the “Law of God”.

Deu 13:1 "If a prophet or a dreamer of dreams arises among you and gives you a sign or a wonder,

Deu 13:2 and the sign or wonder that he tells you comes to pass, and if he says, 'Let us go after other gods,' which you have not known, 'and let us serve them,'

Deu 13:3 you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams. For the LORD your God is testing you, to know whether you love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.

Deu 13:4 You shall walk after the LORD your God and fear him and keep his commandments

and obey his voice, and you shall serve him and hold fast to him.

Deu 13:5 But that prophet or that dreamer of dreams shall be put to death, because he has taught rebellion against the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt and redeemed you out of the house of slavery, to make you leave the way in which the LORD your God commanded you to walk. So you shall purge the evil from your midst.

It should be clear that our Messiah, Yahshua Hamashiach (Jesus Christ) who is and was the son of God would NEVER teach us NOT to keep the commandments of God his father and he never taught anyone NOT to obey his Fathers voice or NOT to serve him or to hold fast to him.

Mat 5:17 "Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them.

Mat 5:18 For truly, I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not an iota, not a dot, will pass from the Law until all is accomplished.

Mat 5:19 Therefore whoever relaxes one of the least of these commandments and teaches others to do the same will be called least in the kingdom of heaven, but whoever does them and teaches them will be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

Mat 5:20 For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.

So did Yahshua, Jesus pass the Deuteronomy 13 test? Yes he did in every way. He NEVER taught anyone not to obey the commandments of his Father. Lets be clear.

There are some very interesting points that Paul makes in verses 3 through 10 as well. Notice verse 5:

Gal 6:5 For each will have to bear his own load.

Once again this goes hand in hand with what our Messiah has always taught.. that we should study to show ourselves approved rightly dividing the Word of God, and once again making sure that we test everything through prayer and supplication.

We are not commanded to go to any specific church and sit in a church pew for 45 minutes on the wrong day of the week calling it the Sabbath of God because some man says so, while we allow him to teach and preach things that are not found in scripture, while programming us not to read the first half of the book that contains the very foundation of the truth of all scripture.

Mat 23:8 But you are not to be called rabbi, for you have one teacher, and you are all brothers.

Mat 23:9 And call no man your father on earth, for you have one Father, who is in heaven.

Mat 23:10 Neither be called instructors, for you have one instructor, the Christ.

Mat 23:11 The greatest among you shall be your servant.

Mat 23:12 Whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be

exalted.

This is a direct commandment from our Messiah, but how many Christians today even know this commandment exists?

So what is the purpose of a Pastor, or a Teacher of Gods Word according to scripture? If you've been with us through our study in the book of Galatians you already know the answer to this one:

*Eph 4:11 And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers,
Eph 4:12 to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ,
Eph 4:13 until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ,
Eph 4:14 so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes.*

Pastors, and teachers, prophets, and evangelists, shepherds, and teachers, are not to have the last word concerning Gods Word. They are to be tested:

Mat 7:16 You will recognize them by their fruits. Are grapes gathered from thornbushes, or figs from thistles?

Mat 7:17 So, every healthy tree bears good fruit, but the diseased tree bears bad fruit.

Mat 7:18 A healthy tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a diseased tree bear good fruit.

Mat 7:19 Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.

Mat 7:20 Thus you will recognize them by their fruits.

And what are these fruits that we are to test? Lets take a look at 1st John 2:4 though 6:

1Jn 2:4 Whoever says "I know him" but does not keep his commandments is a liar, and the truth is not in him,

1Jn 2:5 but whoever keeps his word, in him truly the love of God is perfected. By this we may know that we are in him:

1Jn 2:6 whoever says he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in which he walked.

We should know who these men are standing behind our pulpits when they are not keeping the 7th day Sabbath of God that he said would be a sign between him and his people and a perpetual agreement for all generations...

We should know who these men are standing behind our pulpits when they are not keeping the Passover.. the very day our Messiah died according to Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John...

We should know who these men are standing behind our pulpits when they are not shunning

and fighting against things like the man made, man created, man fabricated first day of the week Sabbath, and “Good Friday” and “Easter, Christmas, Advent, Lent, Valentines Day, and Halloween” and the like.

None of which is found in the scriptures anywhere. We should know who these men are and what they represent. Do they represent the things of the one true God of Abraham, Issac, and Jacob or do they represent the Saducees and Pharisees of our Messiah's time teachings and preaching a mixed bag of truth and lies fabricated by men?.. a hybrid religion manufactured by men and men alone?

Once again 1st John 2:4:

1Jn 2:4 Whoever says "I know him" but does not keep his commandments is a liar, and the truth is not in him,

1Jn 2:5 but whoever keeps his word, in him truly the love of God is perfected. By this we may know that we are in him:

1Jn 2:6 whoever says he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in which he walked.

You see no matter how nice, no matter how heart felt... no matter how smooth, no matter how eloquent they speak, or how elaborate the service... no matter how kindly and old they are.. no matter how much pomp and pageantry they put into their sermons my friends he is either teaching and preaching the whole Word of the one true God of Abraham, Issac, and Jacob or he is not.

And he should not only be preaching them... but keeping them.. and if he is not.. then God says that he is a “Liar, and the truth is not in him”. And make no mistake about it my friends.. I did not say that.. he did.

Now we're going to either believe what is written in the scripture or we're not. It's really that simple. We will choose to obey what God has given us through his scripture or we will choose to obey what is contrary to God. And we will accept the false hybrid religion that Hasiton and his seed is selling us.

If they are teaching you to go after another Sabbath, if they are teaching you to go after another Holiday, if they are teaching you to go after another birthday, if they are teaching you to go after another feast day, if they are teaching you to go after another ritual, or ancient man made, man created, man fabricated myth... then they are teaching you to go after another god.

Jos 24:14 "Now therefore fear the LORD and serve him in sincerity and in faithfulness. Put away the gods that your fathers served beyond the River and in Egypt, and serve the LORD.

Jos 24:15 And if it is evil in your eyes to serve the LORD, choose this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your fathers served in the region beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites

in whose land you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD."

And do not think for one moment that today's modern day denominational churches are not serving the gods of the Amorites in whose land you now dwell my friends!

They are serving the god of Catholicism which is in the land that we now dwell, not found ANYWHERE IN SCRIPTURE!

The majority of today's over 5000 different denominational protestant churches are following right after their mother harlot church who is the Roman Catholic church and it's demonic hierarchy.

To this very day they follow after her fist day of the week Sunday Sabbath, they follow after her Good Friday, her Advent, her Lent, her Easter, her Christmas, her Valentines Day, and even her "All Saints Day" also known as.. "Halloween", which has also been proven to be one of the Devils major holidays, when more children around the world are sacrificed than any other day of the year.

These have NOTHING to do with the scripture and Word of the one true God of Abraham, Issac, and Jacob!

Deu 12:28 Be careful to obey all these words that I command you, that it may go well with you and with your children after you forever, when you do what is good and right in the sight of the LORD your God.

Deu 12:29 "When the LORD your God cuts off before you the nations whom you go in to dispossess, and you dispossess them and dwell in their land,

Deu 12:30 take care that you be not ensnared to follow them, after they have been destroyed before you, and that you do not inquire about their gods, saying, 'How did these nations serve their gods?—that I also may do the same.'

Deu 12:31 You shall not worship the LORD your God in that way, for every abominable thing that the LORD hates they have done for their gods, for they even burn their sons and their daughters in the fire to their gods.

Deu 12:32 "Everything that I command you, you shall be careful to do. You shall not add to it or take from it.

And this is what the book of Galatians is all about my friends! It's not just about "circumcision" it's about "False religion" and every aspect of it. Anything that draws us or leads us away from the original Gospel message that was preached by our Messiah and his Apostles is not to be tolerated!

If I truly believe that All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness.. and if I truly believe that God

commanded me not to add to or take away from his Word.. and if I truly believe that the love of God according to scripture is to keep his commandments, and that his commandments are not a burden to me..

If I truly believe that anyone who says that they know him and does not keep his commandments is a liar and the truth is not in him... if I truly believe that he has written his laws in my heart and my mind.. then how can I not Preach against the false teachings of man!?!?

How can I sit silent in the face of adversity... how can I go along with the wicked denominational teachings of men that lead my brothers and sisters away from God... how can I allow my brothers and sisters to be led into the slaughter house of the wicked one... how can I bury my head in the sand and ignore what God himself has given to me?!?!?

“Oh you can't say that about your brother Pastor”, “Oh you can't talk that way Pastor”, “Oh you can't preach against other Pastors, Priest, Bishops, and Popes Pastor”!... OH YES I CAN!

If I speak in truth according to the scripture of Yahovah God my Father with and in the Authority of his Ruach Hakodesh, and if I myself have picked up my cross and intend to endure to the end, and to contend for the faith... OH YES I CAN! AND WILL!

I will rebuke sharply those who teach contrary to the Gospel of my Messiah that is ONLY found in the Scripture and no where else! I will contend for the faith, and I will not fear what men can do to the body, because I know what my Father can do to both body and soul by casting them into the pit.

And all day long people will say Pastor you need to listen to your brother what if you're wrong Pastor... and to that I say that only if my brother is doing the will of God do I have to listen to him otherwise he is a liar and the truth is not in him!

Why would I listen to someone who says he's a brother, but does not obey the commandments of God himself? I in fact am commanded not to even eat with such a one!

1Co 5:11 But now I am writing to you not to associate with anyone who bears the name of brother if he is guilty of sexual immorality or greed, or is an idolater, reviler, drunkard, or swindler—not even to eat with such a one.

1Co 5:12 For what have I to do with judging outsiders? Is it not those inside the church whom you are to judge?

1Co 5:13 God judges those outside. "Purge the evil person from among you."

What did Paul himself tell the church at Galatia in the book that we just finished studying?!?

Gal 1:6 I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting him who called you in the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel—

Gal 1:7 not that there is another one, but there are some who trouble you and want to distort the gospel of Christ.

Gal 1:8 But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach to you a gospel contrary to the one we preached to you, let him be accursed.

Gal 1:9 As we have said before, so now I say again: If anyone is preaching to you a gospel contrary to the one you received, let him be accursed.

Gal 1:10 For am I now seeking the approval of man, or of God? Or am I trying to please man? If I were still trying to please man, I would not be a servant of Christ.

Gal 1:11 For I would have you know, brothers, that the gospel that was preached by me is not man's gospel.

Gal 1:12 For I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ.

This is a war that we are in my friends... look around... the world is growing more evil and more evil every day, and is the church winning the battle against it? Is the church even in the battle against evil? Is it in the war at all?

Or is it slothfully sleeping? Has the church picked up it's cross and is it wearing the full armor of God standing firm in the evil day or is has it become just as our Messiah said the church had become in his day.. no more than a “brood of vipers, white washed tombs, blind guides, and two fold children of hell”? Teaching and preaching their own man made, man created, man fabricated religion?

Many will say “Oh Pastor but these churches still teach a lot of truth today” and I would remind those people that so did the Pharisees and the Saducees of our Messiah's time teach a lot of truth mixed in with their false man made religion, but that did not stop our Messiah from calling them two fold children of hell in the 23rd chapter of the book of Matthew did it?

Thats what the Devil always has done through out history is to mix lies with truth. He simply repackages the truth with just enough lie to kill you and your children, and he serves it up with heaping gob of whip cream and a cherry on the top to get you to eat it.

It's what he did to Eve in the Garden, it's what he did to the Israelite's, it's what he did to David, it's what he's done with every denominational charter of men on the face of the planet today my friends.

He has not changed his game my friends. And he knows that man will always be willfully ignorant and that he will always refuse to learn from history... and so he knows that we're bound to repeat it so every generation is all to eager to accept the same old trick over and over and over again, and so it has been for centuries.

What did even Solomon tell us? “There is nothing new under the sun”.

Most professing Christians today if you walked up outside of a church on a Sunday afternoon couldn't even tell you what the greatest commandment is let alone which day the true Sabbath of God is.

This war that Paul had to fight for the Church at Galatia my friends is the same war that we fight today. It's the same trick of the Devil today as it was back then. It's all about the truth of Gods Word verses the Devil's religion of truth and lie mixed together. Like iron and clay one does not cling to another my friends.

In closing what does Paul say in verses 15 through 18:

Gal 6:15 For neither circumcision counts for anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation.

Gal 6:16 And as for all who walk by this rule, peace and mercy be upon them, and upon the Israel of God.

Gal 6:17 From now on let no one cause me trouble, for I bear on my body the marks of Jesus.

Gal 6:18 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit, brothers. Amen.

“For neither circumcision counts for anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation.” As we've already learned through this study, he might as well have said “For neither baptism counts for anything or un-baptism, but a new creation”.

You see with out faith.. neither circumcision or baptism count for anything. Apart from faith in our Messiah nothing you can do with your hands counts for anything. Circumcision and Baptism do not lead us to faith.. but only the obedience of faith can lead us to a circumcision or a baptism that means anything in the eyes of our Father and his son.

It is the circumcision of the heart and the baptism of the Ruach Hakodesh, (the Holy Spirit) that leads us to the obedience of faith. And then and only then are circumcision or baptism of any effect. It must be the love of God that causes us to be circumcised and baptized as he commanded us to be.

2Jn 1:6 And this is love, that we walk according to his commandments; this is the commandment, just as you have heard from the beginning, so that you should walk in it.

Eze 11:19 And I will give them one heart, and a new spirit I will put within them. I will remove the heart of stone from their flesh and give them a heart of flesh,

Eze 11:20 that they may walk in my statutes and keep my rules and obey them. And they shall

be my people, and I will be their God.

Jer 31:33 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the LORD: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

Heb 10:15 And the Holy Spirit also bears witness to us; for after saying,

Heb 10:16 "This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, declares the Lord: I will put my laws on their hearts, and write them on their minds,"

Heb 10:17 then he adds, "I will remember their sins and their lawless deeds no more."

I hope and pray that this teaching on the book of Galatians has been a blessing to you and to your family, and that you too will decide to pick up your cross and to contend for the faith, and rebuke sharply those who contradict it.

Let us pray for the strength to endure to the end as it is written... in Matthew 24:13, Hebrews 3:14, Revelation 2:26 and 27 and in so many other places through out the scripture..

For we know that it is not everyone who says "Lord Lord" that will be saved.. but only those who do the will of our Father who is in Heaven... Mathew 7:21
